Recommendations

Celebrating International Women's Day today in a world affected by Corona, the Women's Conference of the Working Women's Welfare Trust recommends that

- 1. In light of the successful experience of Corona, special legislation should be enacted to provide work-from-home facility for women workers in which the parties have the power to discharge their responsibilities within legal and ethical limits.
- 2. Immediate reversal of salary deductions due to corona
- 3. Overall survey reports have shown that during the global epidemic, people living in joint family systems coped better with the problems caused by the disease and the epidemic and avoided many problems, so the conference recommends that the working hours and conditions of employment should be made family friendly for the stability and survival of the larger social organization "Family".
- 4. Special programs should be set up under the Ministry of Women Welfare and Chambers of Commerce to facilitate marketing and business to all women entrepreneurs.
- 5. The Ministry and the Chamber should set up e-portals to facilitate testing and marketing of the products and services provided by these women.
- 6. Ensure the provision of environment in the offices and production units in accordance with the principles of hygiene.
- 7. In the supply of Corona vaccine, priority should be given to front line workers and women working in factories and other institutions after the elderly.
- 8. In order to control inflation, the prices of essential commodities should be fixed and artificial increase in and scarcity should be strictly curbed.
- 9. Instead of raising electricity and gas prices, subsidy should be given for two years. Appropriate steps should be taken to curb the sharp rise in residential rents.
- 10 Alternatives to online classes should be sought to revive the education system so that working and low-income and resourceful mothers can also continue their children's educational activities.
- 11. Provide safe and convenient transport to women workers.
